## March SEN Corner

This month I wanted to share some information on dyslexia.

Dyslexia is a specific learning difficulty that alters the way that the brain processes the written word and is characterised by difficulties in recognising, spelling and decoding words. As such, children with dyslexia also have problems with reading comprehension.

We can screen children for dyslexia at school after their  $7^{\text{th}}$  birthday. It is not a diagnosis - it gives us an indication of areas of weakness. We call it an 'At risk' score.

Once we are aware of the areas of weakness we can support children through interventions.




