As part of KS2 Personal, Social and Health Education Mr Fugill and Mrs Kilpin will be holding two sessions on Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) for Years 5 and 6 on Monday 25th and Tuesday 26th June.



This involves the showing of a Channel 4 DVD in three parts, followed by discussions as both a whole class and in gender groups afterwards. This will give the children a chance to ask any questions that might be worrying them or to explore any misconceptions.



The aims of SRE in this school are:

- To enable our pupils to better understand the nature of human relationships
- To enable pupils to see the importance of marriage and stable loving relationships for the bringing up of children
- To prepare pupils for the changes that occur to their bodies, minds and emotions as a consequence of growth from childhood to adulthood.
