



Dear Kilmar parents,

21st September 2018

We would like to thank everyone who was able to attend the meetings regarding the proposed trip to Warner Brothers Harry Potter Studio and your invaluable suggestions. By general consensus of agreement, the trip will be going ahead on **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2018**. The coach will leave Lewannick Primary School car park at **6.00am** and return at approximately **12.00am –midnight**. We will have a comfort break at a motorway services on the outward journey and stop for a fast food meal on the return trip. 6 Adults will be accompanying the children.

At this moment in time we are asking for payment to cover the cost of the entrance tickets. Please **pay £18.00** to the school office by **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> October**.

Unfortunately, we were unable to increase our ticket allocation so Boyton Primary will not be joining us. Therefore, the total cost of the trip will be no more than £50 per child (including the ticket cost but not their evening meal). We are planning a range of fund raising events to reduce the transport costs. As a result, we will send out a further letter after 10<sup>th</sup> October regarding these events, paying in instalments and the final total cost of the trip.

Your child / children will need to bring:

- A packed breakfast
- A packed lunch – *neither the breakfast nor the lunch can be provided by the school for this trip as the school building will not be open (please toilet before arrival)*.
- Maximum of £10 in a named wallet /money bag etc for their evening meal.
- Their school jumper. They do not have to wear full school uniform, however they must wear their school jumper whilst in the studio for easy identification purpose and their safety.

The following items are optional

- A pillow and/ or a blanket for them to sleep under on the homeward journey.
- Top Trumps, books to read, colouring in books with pencils (not felt tips) in a case etc.
