Coronavirus Update

Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to update you and clarify the current situation in relation to the school, government advice and our current approaches.

As it stands, we have not been instructed to close the school. We are continuing with our pre-existing measures focusing on hand hygiene and being vigilant to symptoms. Our cleaner is cleaning extensively to reduce the spread of germs.

We have had no confirmed cases of Covid-19 (Coronavirus) in the school at this time.

Following the meeting held by Boris Johnson and COBRA group on Monday 16th March – the following advice has been implemented:

- Anyone who has the symptoms (High temperature and/**OR** a repetitive, continuous cough) should self-isolate. This has been extended to include family members who live with the person with those symptoms, - to self-isolate for 14 days, irrespective of how they feel.
- Children who are suspected of having a high fever and/**OR** a repetitive, continuous cough are to be sent home from school immediately (or not attend school) and are not to return for at least 14 days (7 days if a person lives alone – so irrelevant here).

We appreciate that this may cause difficulty for many parents, but we also know that you will appreciate that this is a rapidly changing, dynamic situation that changes almost minute by minute. We will keep you updated as much as we can.
