Dear Parents/Carers,

No doubt you will have been aware of the press and measures implemented by the Government surrounding the current Coronavirus situation.

The Government has now instructed schools in England to close in response to the situation. I am writing to you to explain how we will meet the educational provision for your child in light of this implementation.



I am sure you are fully aware that this is a difficult situation and the staff and I have worked hard on considering the best approach to make the work, meaningful, relevant and easy to access for you and your child.

We will be reviewing this weekly to ensure that we respond to feedback and are best placed to make this provision effective.

We will be communicating the work via each class's page on the website:

On the main menu top bar, you will need to go to class pages (under the section headed: school) and click on the relevant class page for your child.

In Fox Class, go to 'Our Learning'

In Owls Class, go to 'This Term'

In Otters and Kestrels, go to 'Homework'

On this page, you will find 4x pieces of English work (writing), 4x pieces of reading comprehension (following the VIPERS structure that the children are familiar with), 4x pieces of Maths and relevant Topic related work tasks. These will be updated weekly or daily depending on how the class teacher chooses to organise it.



As well as these tasks, there will be links to instructional videos (explaining the concept or skill being taught) if relevant and a range of websites or Apps that will support an aspect of your child's learning. These will be under constant review, so please check regularly.

Once your child has completed the task – either online or printed out, we ask that you either send the completed work or a photo of the completed work to the relevant class teacher via their email address on the class page.



The class teacher will mark the work and email you back with feedback and relevant development points where necessary.

We appreciate that some of you may not have IT facilities. Therefore, where this is the case, we will be providing paper copies of tasks in folders. These will be updated every week.

Paper copies will be available to collect from a class box that will be in a black plastic trunk which will be located near the front entrance.

The above will take effect from Monday 23rd March.

Following the Easter break we will at the same time, every week, be in school for a designated period (to be indicated on the website) where you can come and change your child's reading book and discuss aspects of the work with your child's teacher. Please only attend school at these times, if you are free from symptoms of Coronavirus and have been for at least 14 days.

As stated earlier, this whole process is subject to regular review and we will be sending further letters to you and keeping you updated over the period of school closure.
