Gymnastics	Weekly 2x hour sessions for Spring Term 6 weeks in duration of fully qualified Gymnastics coach to teach high quality gymnastics and train up teachers.	Children in assessments had all improved in core strength and skill level. Many children made enquiries as to local gym clubs following sessions.
Zumba	Weekly 2x hour sessions from a qualified Zumba instructor for 8 weeks as part of alternative physical activity provision opportunities.	Evaluations from the children were positive with the younger children. Teachers expressed more confidence in teaching dance based sessions in future planning.
Plymouth Argyle	1x weekly afternoon and after school club sports and football provision.	Club available to all age phases and taken up. Children were mix of boys and girls and many have gone on to join local football clubs outside of school.

Horse Riding Therapy	1x afternoon weekly session 12 wks for two children with EHCP to access physical activity and therapy opportunities.	Both children and parents highly valued this opportunity and it significantly supported their emotional well being and calmness.
PE day Supply Cover	Supply booked so that PE lead could attend day training course	PE lead came back with many new ideas and guidance on the overseeing of PE provision.
Netball	Additional training and club sessions with netball coach.	The school Y5/6 Netball team won through for the first time ever from regional tournament to Cornwall County Games.
Cornish Pirates	5 weeks of sessions form trained rugby coaches to teach TAG rugby correctly and instruct and train teachers.	Children have gone on to join local rugby teams outside of school and staff indicate an increased confidence in the teaching of TAG.
Multi-skills travel and primary festivals	Children from Y1 through to Y6 involved in festivals.	Y3/4 team one regional events three times.
Top up swimming	10 week hire of pool, instructor and lifeguard for children targeted to achieve 25m swimming distance.	All children left Y6 able to swim 25m. School is now moving down through the year groups to ensure children achieve this goal earlier.
Football Club Support	4 x 1 hours TA overtime to support an SEND child to have access to football club which without it, would have been impossible.	SEND child fully engaged and enjoyed football club.
Sailing	1x day at Roadford Lake including Sailing, raft building and high wires – travel, instruction and equipment.	Children highly evaluated the day and many have made further enquiries as to following this sport.
Arena Network Membership	Access to competitions, support, planning and curricular advice	This membership has facilitated all of the above ideas and initiatives.
Balance Bikes	Purchase of 10 balance bikes for EYFS and Y1 & 2	Children have moved on to riding bikes quicker than historically – teachers report the children are displaying better balance.
