Dear Parent/Carers,

School Uniform

We have taken the decision to re-introduce the wearing of school uniform to the school, with effect from Monday 2nd November. Please can I ask you to support us with this.

As the weather changes and days are a lot cooler we would encourage children to wear layers under their uniform - base layers, long sleeve t-shirts, tights etc and to have access to a thin fleece jacket like top, to wear over their uniform in class. Please don't feel compelled to buy anything, as lots of smaller thin layers is more effective at retaining heat. Guidance is still that, doors and windows should remain open to allow for a constant flow of fresh air through the indoor spaces and we will be continuing with this until we are advised otherwise. We will of course alongside this, be monitoring the temperatures of the rooms closely.

Up until half term, children can continue to wear 'home clothes' as they have been but we would again encourage them to wear layers under their clothing.

Children continue to need a full set of waterproofs and wellies in school with them at all times, as part of our on-going measure to prevent Covid, we will be continuing with learning outdoors as much as possible.
