Dear Parents/Carers

As you are no doubt aware, from Thursday the country is placed into another form of lockdown as the government takes this step to manage the situation in relation to Coronavirus.

I wanted to write to you to confirm that school will remain open as instructed by the government. Currently, schools are not being instructed to be closed during this lockdown period. I am following the news and guidance closely and if this situation is reassessed and that instruction from the government changes, I will of course immediately inform you.

We want to ensure that our measures for managing the risk of a Coronavirus infection are constantly reviewed and are as effective and as safe as possible. As part of this review process, we have identified a couple of changes that we feel would enable our processes to be even more effective at this time.

From Thursday we are asking that children (unless part of a sibling group with children in both drop off/collection times), are dropped off at the beginning of the day and collected at the end of the day within the allocated time slots:

Kestrels and Otters - Drop off between 8.30am and 8.45am
Kestrels and Otters - Collection between 3.30pm and 3.45pm

Foxes and Owls - Drop off between 8.45am and 9am
Foxes and Owls - Collection between 3.15pm and 3.30pm

Sibling groups with children in both drop off/collection times can be dropped from 8.45am and collected at 3.30pm.

If we can stick to these times, it allows our one-way system to be managed with increasing social distance.

If your child attends Breakfast Club, they can come into school for the appropriate time.

We are also asking that as soon as possible after collecting or dropping your child off, you maintain social distancing at the school gates and along Hawks Tor Drive.

Thank you for your support with this. With your help and support, we have managed the first half of the Autumn Term effectively. We feel that with these increased measures, this will increase the effectiveness and safety of our systems even further.
