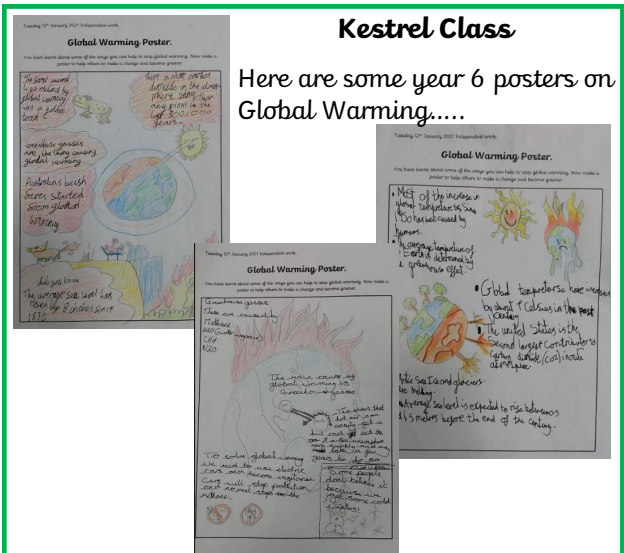

Kestrel Class

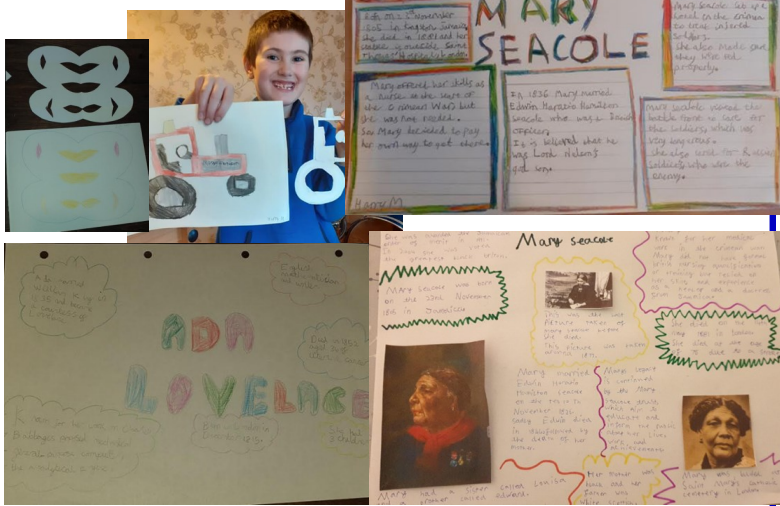
Here are some year 6 posters on Global Warming....
