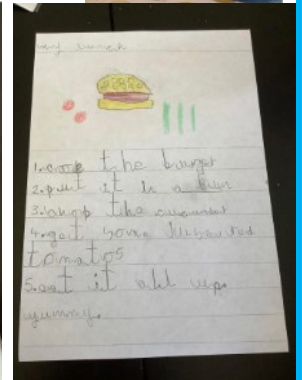
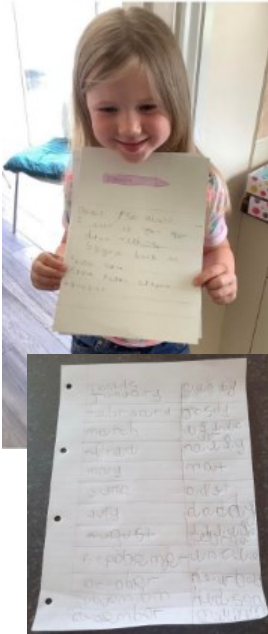

Otter Class have had an interesting week.

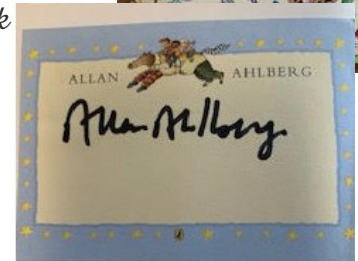
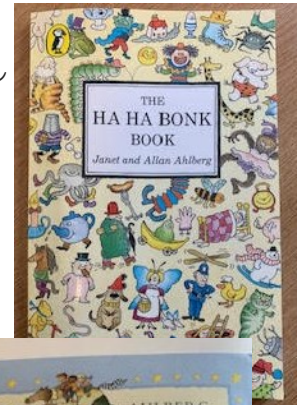
We started with doing some end of year tests which the children have some great resilience and independence to complete.

Owl Class

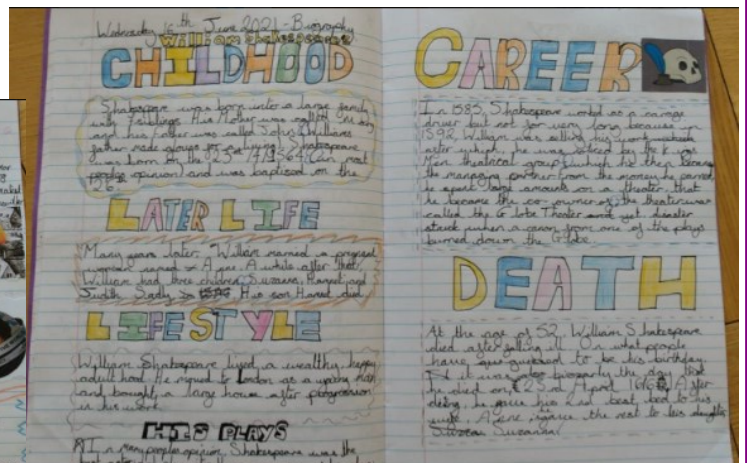
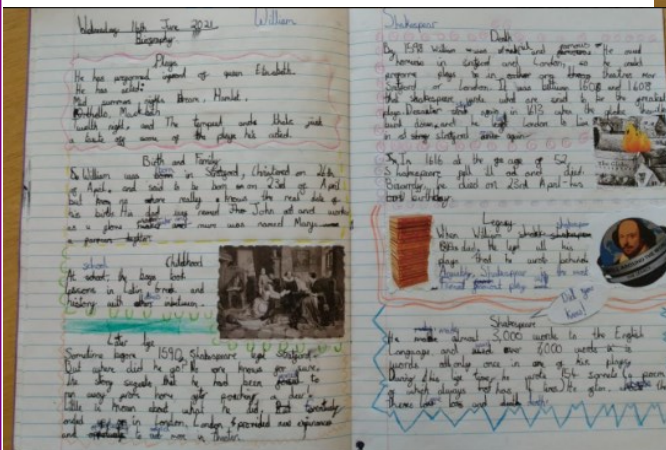
Owl Class have been extremely lucky to receive an email and a signed book from Allan Ahlberg. We have been enjoying all the jokes this week. Here is what the email said...
