### Literacy:

A variety of texts will be studied in writing and reading including Beetle Boy and Non fiction texts.

SPaG—Use of different conjunctions to create compound and complex sentences, using a variety of sentence starters and use of correct speech punctuation in a variety of text types. When writing non-fiction, we will be focusing on using organisational devices to organise our paragraphs as well as ensuring we consistently write in the correct tense, use appropriate determiners and pronouns to prevent repetition. We will be consolidating our knowledge of previously taught spelling rules and be starting to learn Year 5 / 6 common exception words.

We will also be learning about separating mixtures using filtering, sieving and evaporation, learning that some substances will dissolve whilst others won't and consolidating our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases.
